

Uncertainty




Acting Alone or Acting Collectively?

Invest in licenses, or capability?




"The Cloud" - Concerns

What is needed to support open code? 3 Main elements ...




1. Committed Individuals

Outreach is an overhead


Enlightened self-interest Every Opencast user an Opencast champion




